-PRACTICING: Now that we are setting drillson the parking lot, this has become a part of our curriculum. Pass offs with directors will now move over to drill. Students may need to come to the parking lot, periodically, by themselves to make sure they are prepared for these pass offs. To perform at halftime for the first game, students must have all their pass-offs completed up to the end of Mvt. 1 and 2. Our goal is to perform Mvts 1 and 2 on Friday September 19th, but we will keep working on Mvt 3 and getting closer to having that as part of our production.

-We will be wearing uniforms for the game on September 19th. Students please be ready to accommodate that day and time. We try to wait until the first season games to do full uniform, and we are almost there!!

-AFTERSCHOOL: Students are REQUIRED to be out of the halls at 2:50 pm. Students must be working on homework in the band hall and make sure they are completing all assignments. Students failing grade checks are not using this time wisely. In addition, it is our recommendation that students bring a lunch/snack to eat during this time to be in the band hall doing homework vs. leaving and not keeping up on assignments. Frequent failing grade reports will result in a student being pulled from marching games/contests/or losing varsity spots.

-Our first stadium rehearsal is scheduled for Tuesday September 23rd 6-8:30. This is a VERY important rehearsal at Challenger stadium. We will have buses take us to Challenger at 5 pm. The call time is 4:30 at the band hall for all band students.

-The first STATE-WIDE grade check is coming up. All grades close on Friday September 19th, and teachers have until Tuesday September 23rd at 4 pm to submit all grades. Students who are not passing at that time will not be allowed to travel to games or contests starting at 2:35 pm on Friday September 26th. They will not be allowed to return unless all grades are passing on the next grade check 3 WEEKS after. They cannot regain eligibility until after that time. It is imperative that students make sure they are checking grades DAILY to not be deemed ineligible. For more information, please see the band handbook under ELIGIBILITY.

Full Uniform for this game! For rehearsal we will wear our green dri-fits, black shorts (school appropriate length), LONG black socks, and band shoes to Run-throughs (part of grade) and the game. Not having any of these items may prevent them from marching or attending the game. We will travel in our bibblers and students must be in full uniform before exiting the bus at Deer Park. No uniform components may be half-worn when exiting the bus. Students, please send your full uniform pictures to your leadership on Thursday evening: 1. Powerflex shirt, 2. Bibbers, 3. Green Dri-fit, 4. Long Black Socks, 5. Black Shorts, 6. Band Shoes, 7. Sheiko box with sheiko, 8. Tuner, 9. Flip Folder

Students will eat dinner in the area right outside of the auditorium and house 3. We ask that the band does not leave a mess anywhere we occupy space. Leadership keeps an eye on these areas and is prepared to clean up in the event the band does not. Students can eat and visit, there should be no other activities during this time. **STUDENTS MAY NOT BE IN ANY OTHER AREAS OF THE SCHOOL.** For inspection, your student will need to show your lyre (if applicable), flip folder, water bottle, and RAIN PONCHO. Students, please make sure you have a lyre. **STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO INSPECT WITHOUT ALL PROPER GEAR ON.** Uniform components should not be changed from rehearsal to inspection to loading the bus due to items being left in past games.

After we return to the band hall, please put all items away before leaving the band hall. Please understand that although 11:15 pm is estimated, there is a chance we could arrive earlier or later depending on the course of the football game. If the football team passes for most of the game, it could move slower and cause us to be later.

Please do not pick students up in front of the band hall after the game, as it will be blocked off for the pit to unload and safely cross the street into the band hall. We also ask that parents do not park in the horseshoe in front of the school as that is where the buses will drop off the band. Please pull into a parking space and wait for your band student to exit the band hall. Also, please do not park in the handicap spaces unless you have a tag or license plate with a handicap designation. Students/chaperones do not leave your cars parked in the first 6 spaces closest to the band hall in the parking lot as the truck unloading will happen in those spaces.
