-Welcome to the first Knights Creed of the 2026-2027 school year! We hope that the following information will give you a guide as we proceed. We know your students will have an amazing experience in our program!!!

-Summer band is upon us! We began on Monday July 13th with the guard, leadership, and percussion only. Congratulations to these groups for getting off to an amazing start! We are very proud of you.

-The rest of the band will join us on Monday July 20th (percussion and guard will adhere to this schedule change as well) We begin at 7 am and the band will meet in the marching band parking lot. The camp will run to 6:30 pm with lunch from noon to 1 pm daily. Due to heat, our outside portions will be limited, and we will follow the district/state guidelines regarding heat. Our student's health is of our utmost concern and we will make sure the students are not in an unsafe environment. Please eat a protein filled breakfast (anything with milk/dairy should not be consumed!!!) before arriving and bring snacks for throughout the day breaks (No carbonated beverages).

-As with the percussion and guard camp, 9th grade students will not be allowed to leave with upper classmen unless it is a sibling. Students must bring all equipment (both concert and marching, instruments if applicable), wear athletic clothing, and bring a 1/2 gallon jug of water. Students who cannot get a ride for lunch may bring a lunch to eat **IN THE BAND HALL ONLY**. No eating in other parts of the school or wandering to other parts of the school. Students that do not have a half gallon jug of water will be asked to leave and return once they have one. Also, students **MUST** have an approved physical uploaded on RANKONE before they can participate.

- For the next week (July 28th-August 1st), our schedule will run from **TUESDAY** to **SATURDAY** (instead of Monday-Thursday), at the same times (7 am to 6:30 pm). Saturday August 1st will be from 7-10am.

-Starting the week of August 3rd, we will do 4-8 pm times Monday-Thursday. That Friday (August 7th), we will have our Band Lock-In from 5-10 pm, location is the Clear Falls Gymnasiums. The Lock-In is not mandatory, just a fun event for surviving summer band! More details to follow!

-If your student has not passed off Mvt. 1 to a section leader yet, please encourage your student to do so. Most bands across the state will not do this so we can use this to get ahead.

-**WEEKLY GOALS!** We will send the weekly goals for the wind playing students (brass and woodwinds) on a separate email. After this week, goals will be sent out on Fridays, so students have the weekend to prepare for Monday and Tuesday and utilize the rest of the week to stay ahead. **THE GOAL SHEETS ARE THE LIFE-BLOOD OF OUR PROGRAM!** (hold CTRL+click the link_
